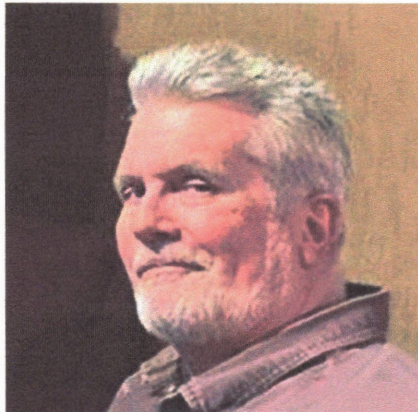


Eddie Withrow
