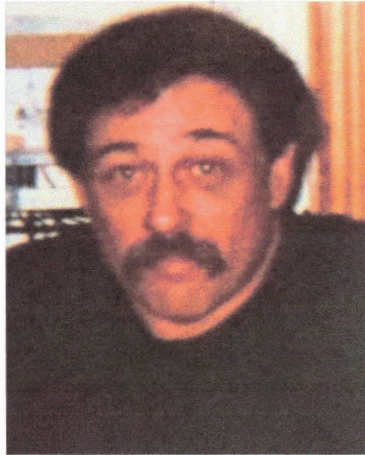


Robert Lee “Bob” Knight
